### **The following is an extract from a legal opinion obtained by the Australian Airport Association:**

Accordingly, in the absence of any breach of an applicable law on our part, we do not accept any liability for injury or damage that may be sustained if, in the course of your use of our aerodrome, your aircraft strikes an animal within the confines of the aerodrome.

### **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**

1. Prior permission required.
2. Pilot to be satisfied that the ALA is suitable for his operation.
3. Tyre pressure is in accordance with AIP 'unrated pavements'.
